Configuring Windows Server (2008 R2 IIS and above) to allow Softinterface application to run from a third party app (e.g. ASP.Net website)

- 1. If you don't already have one, create a local account on the machine and add it to the "Administrators" group.
- 2. Open IIS Manager:
 - a. Click start
 - b. Type "inetmgr" and hit enter.
- 3. In the left hand pane of IIS Manager expand the node with the same name as the server (see figure 1-1)
- 4. Next click Application Pools (figure 1-2)
- 5. In the middle pane select the application pool that your site is using (figure 1-3)
- 6. In the right pane click the Advanced Settings... link (figure 1-4)

7. In the Advanced Settings dialog click the button to the right of the **Identity** setting in the **Process Model** section.
